Tentative Agreement Reached

The two Negotiating Teams reached a tentative agreement on a new Collective Agreement earlier today.

Member feedback has proven invaluable during this process. Thank you.

The next step in the process is that the BUFA Executive must meet to review the content of the tentative Agreement and make a determination on whether to recommend to members that the proposed Collective Agreement be ratified. This meeting will be held as soon as possible.

If the BUFA Executive decides to recommend ratification of the tentative Agreement, it will call a special General Membership Meeting (GMM). A summary of the proposed Agreement will be made available on the BUFA website prior to the GMM and members will be able to access a copy of the full text of the Agreement in the members area on the [BUFA website](#).

At the meeting, the Chief Negotiator will present details of the tentative Agreement and members will be able to ask questions. Members will then be asked to vote on ratification of the new contract electronically.

The tentative Agreement also will need to be ratified by Brock's Board of Trustees before it is finalized.

We look forward to discussing details of the tentative Agreement with members in the near future.
